Overview

- 🌱 New functionality released on June 17, 2013
 - Saving forms without all required fields
 - Marking forms as complete
 - Locking forms to prepare for submission to long-term repository
- 🌱 Bug fixes
 - Correct Visit Date prepopulation

New Functionality – June 2013

-  Ability to save forms without completing all required fields
-  Marking forms as complete
-  Locking forms triggers submission to long-term repository

New Functionality – Instructions

- Ability to save forms without entering all required data
 - The system will now allow you to navigate through your forms using the buttons at the bottom of a collection even if you have not filled in all required fields
 - Forms will save as “In Progress”
- When you are complete with a form, check the Mark as Completed checkbox (arrow #1)
 - Triggers required field validation
 - Form saves with “Completed” status if all required fields are complete
 - Forms cannot be locked until they are Completed; Lock button is disabled for In Progress forms

New Functionality – Instructions

- 🌱 Locking forms will trigger submission to long-term repository
 - The Operations team will be reaching out to each site with further instructions on when and what to lock.
 - Please do NOT lock forms without explicit instructions from the Operations team
- 🌱 Once data has been loaded into the long-term repository, we will provide instructions on accessing it using the Query Tool
- 🌱 We expect data to be submitted to the long-term repository gradually over the next several weeks
- 🌱 Access to Query Tool will be granted later this summer once forms have been submitted and validated
- 🌱 Query Tool training will be provided at the September in-person meeting

Bug Fixes – June 2013

- 🌱 Visit Date prepopulation maintains Visit Date on Start Collections page

Bug Fixes – Instructions

-  Visit Date will now be prepopulated with the same value that you chose on the Start Collection page, even as you navigate through the forms using the Previous and Next Form buttons and the links at the bottom of the page.
-  The Operations team will coordinate with each site to update previous form collections so that your dates are consistent across a visit.
